Procedure for obtaining permission to purchase a *National Huguenot Society* insignia to mark a member's grave:

1. A request for purchase and placement of a *National Huguenot Society* insignia grave marker **must** be made through the State Society in which the membership is/was held.
2. Names should be complete, i.e., Janet Sue Smith Johnson (Mrs. Robert B. Johnson).
3. The State Society is authorized to complete and sign the Permission Form and submit it to the Registrar General, with a check for \$10, payable to the Treasurer General, *National Huguenot Society*, for final approval.
4. The approved, signed form will be sent to the member or designated family member to forward **with payment** to the firm authorized to reproduce the insignia. Information on the authorized company will be supplied by the Registrar General at the time of application.
5. After the grave is marked, *The National Huguenot Society* headquarters office and the Historian General are to be informed of the date that the marker was set, accompanied by a copy of the completed Permission Form.
